Location, location, location!
Reserve? -You have to watch it here.
Non-circ video? -You have to watch it here.

Available only means nobody has it checked out. It might be on reserve or a non-circulating title or a laserdisc.

A laserdisc is not a DVD. A laserdisc is 12 inches in diameter, basically the same size as a vinyl LP record. You more than likely will not have a player to use it.

A non-circ video or DVD is a non-circulating item. Students have to watch it here. It is a title that would be difficult to replace, usually an expensive item, part of a multivolume set or something that is on required for course work constantly.

In cataloging means the item is not processed. It has arrived in the building but it doesn't have a complete record or labels etc. You can ask to be notified when it is ready for use.
