#### Baseball Player of the Week

##### Gordy Webb, Bates

(Sophomore, Catcher - Hampden, Maine)  
 Webb batted .611 (11-for-18) with a .632 on-base percentage and a 1.111 slugging mark while not committing an error behind the plate during the Bobcats' 3-2 week. He hit four doubles, a triple and a home run while scoring seven runs and batting in four. During Sunday's doubleheader sweep of Colby, Webb combined to go 5-for-8 from the dish. He also threw out three runners on seven stolen base attempts on the week.

#### Baseball Pitcher of the Week

##### Pat Driscoll, Bowdoin

(Senior, RHP - Braintree, Mass.)  
 Driscoll recorded a win and a save last week for the Polar Bears without allowing a run. He picked up the save during a mid-week win against Southern Maine, 7-4, before tossing six innings of shutout ball in a 3-0 decision against Thomas on Sunday. In 7.0 IP, Driscoll allowed two hits and struck out five, holding opposing batters to a .095 average.

**Notes:** Amherst freshman OF Kevin Heller (Brooklyn, N.Y.) led the Lord Jeffs during a 1-2 week, batting .429 (6-for-14) and scoring five runs while driving in two. He also had a home run and was 3-for-3 in stolen base attempts. Sophomore pitcher Pat Harris (Rochester, N.Y.) made a pair of relief appearances, posting a 2.08 ERA over 8.2 IP and recording a win. He struck out seven batters and held opponents to a .138 average...Bates sophomore RHP Paul Chiampa (Bryantville, Mass.) had a 2.57 ERA over 7.0 IP, winning his lone appearance while holding opponents to a .259 average. He struck out 11 batters, the most in a single game for the Bobcats since Billy Karz had 11 in a 9-inning game against Me.-Farmington in 2002, and surrendered only one walk...Bowdoin head coach Mike Connolly garnered his 190th career victory on Sunday in a 3-0 win over Thomas, setting the program record for wins by a coach...Colby senior SS Craig Cooper (Trumbull, Conn.) batted .500 (5-for-10) for the Mules in a 1-2 week, scoring three runs and driving in six others. He also had a stole base, a home run, and three walks...Hamilton freshman OF Sam Choate (Weston, Mass.) batted .444 (4-for-9) in a split Sunday series against Amherst. In game one, Choate drove in the tying and game-winning runs with a double with one out in the bottom of the seventh for a 5-4 Continental victory. In the second game of the day, Choate went 3-for-5 with a three-run homer. Senior pitcher Jake Saidman (Kingston, Pa.) allowed one earned run on three hits in seven innings during a no-decision against Amherst on Sunday, walking three and fanning two in the outing...Middlebury junior SS Danny Seymour (Weston, Conn.) posted an average of .571 (8-for-14) over a 2-1 week with three runs scored and two RBI...Trinity senior catcher Sean Killeen (Greenfield, Mass.) batted .385 with a .923 slugging percentage and a .556 OBP, collecting two home runs, five walks, six RBI and four runs scored...Tufts freshman 2B Sam Sager (Cranston, R.I.) hit .333 with two doubles, four runs scored and a stolen base. He was also perfect on 15 fielding chances. Junior Tom Hill (Robbinsville, N.J.) allowed no runs on three hits and struck out three during 4.1 innings of work out of the bullpen last week...Wesleyan senior SS/P Drew Dominguez (Braintree, Mass.) batted .667 (6-for-9) with a 1.556 slugging percentage as he hit two home runs, both coming against Middlebury, and two doubles during a 1-1 weekend. Dominguez also had five runs scored and five RBI...Williams junior LF Al Mathews (Northampton, N.H.) hit .625 (10-for-16) and had a .684 OBP and .750 slugging percentage during a 4-0 week for the Ephs. He also drove in 12 runs and scored five while accumulating three walks. In a 22-8 win over Thomas on Wednesday, Mathews went 5-for-5 with a double, a stolen base and six RBI.
