Offensive Co-Players of the Week

Oliver Kell, Bowdoin

(Junior, QB - Westford, Mass.)

Kell powered the Polar Bear offense during their 17-10 win at Wesleyan. Kell completed 24-of-31 passes for 229 yards and one touchdown while gaining 113 yards on 30 carries and running for the game-winning score with 1:31 left to play. He posted a pass efficiency rating of 150.12.

Brian Morrissey, Williams

(Senior, RB - Winchester, Mass.)

The conference's leading rusher, Morrissey carried the ball a school-record 42 times for 201 yards, an average of 4.8 yards per carry, and scored the game-winning touchdown from six yards out with 2:12 remaining in the Ephs' 14-7 win over Hamilton.

Defensive Player of the Week

Kyle McAllister, Bates

(Junior, FS - Exeter, N.H.)

McAllister had a big day for the Bobcats in their first win of the season, a 31-21 victory against Colby. McAllister collected seven tackles (six solo), an interception, two forced fumbles and two fumble recoveries. McAllister picked up one of his two caused fumbles and returned the ball 41 yards for a touchdown.

Special Teams Player of the Week

Sam Viering, Trinity

(Sophomore, KR - Ponte Verde Beach, Fla.)

Viering scored the game-winning touchdown on an 85-yard kickoff return in the fourth quarter in a 34-31 win over Middlebury. Vierung finished the game with 142 total return yards on five kickoffs.

Notes: Amherst sophomore QB Alex Vetras (Clyde Hill, Wash.) completed 26-of-38 passes for 246 yards and a pair of touchdowns for a 147.96 pass efficiency rating to lead the Lord Jeffs to a 24-17 win over Tufts on Saturday. Both of Vetras' touchdowns came during the second quarter to help Amherst establish a 21-0 halftime lead. Vetras spread the ball to eight different receivers in the victory. Junior ILB Mike Taylor (Evanston, Ill.) had seven tackles (three solo), 3.0 tackles for a combined loss of 13 yards, an interception, a pass break-up and 2.0 sacks for a loss of 11 yards. Taylor's pick came in the second quarter to help the Jeffs shutout Tufts in the first half. Junior PK/P Matt Eberhart (Plano, Texas) hit his lone field goal attempt of the day from 35 yards out and was a perfect 3-for-3 on PAT in the win. He also punted eight times for an average of 36.9 yards, including a long of 48 yards...Bates freshman QB Ryan Katon (Durham, Conn.) completed 13-of-23 passes for 139 yards and career-high three touchdowns to stake the Bobcats to a 21-0 lead en route to a 31-21 win over Colby. It was Bates first win over Colby since 2002. Sophomore P/K Gavin Segall-Abrams (Greensboro, N.C.) made all four PAT attempts and hit a 27-yard field goal in the fourth quarter, the first of his career, that helped seal the Bobcats' win. He also averaged 54.5 yards on six kickoff attempts and 30.3 yards on seven punts...Bowdoin senior LB Damon Hall-Jones (Milton, Mass.) led the Polar Bears' best defensive performance of the season in Saturday's win over Wesleyan. Hall-Jones made eight solo tackles, including three for a loss, and intercepted a pass to give Bowdoin its first win in the Constitution State since 1996...Hamilton junior LB John Lawrence (Baldwinsville, N.Y.) accounted for all of the Continentals' points in a 14-7 loss against Williams on Saturday. Lawrence returned an interception 69 yards for a touchdown. He finished the game with six tackles and broke up three passes. Lawrence has intercepted a pass in five straight games and now has eight picks for his career...Middlebury sophomore QB Donald McKillop (Poway, Calif.) threw for 325 yards with three touchdowns, two going to Andrew Matson (Coventry, R.I.) in the Panthers' 34-31 setback at Trinity on Saturday. Ryan Bohling (Westport, Conn.) rushed for 103 yards in the loss. Junior DB Dan Haluska (Wellesley, Mass.) tied a program record with three interceptions at Trinity, leading to 10 points for the Panthers. Haluska returned one interception 26 yards for a touchdown. He also had a team-high 11 tackles (nine solo) while also adding a pass break-up...Trinity senior WR Connor Wells (Haddam, Conn.) caught six passes for a game-high 132 yards in the Bantams' 34-31 win over Middlebury. Sophomore ILB Francois Auzeais (Westport, Conn.) totaled nine tackles (seven solo) and added an interception in Trinity's win...Tufts senior receiver David Halas (Southbury, Conn.) set a program record for touchdown receptions in a single season with eight after he caught two touchdown passes in Saturday's game at Amherst. Halas now has 16 touchdown catches during his career, extending the all-time Jumbo mark which he previously broke at Bowdoin on Oct. 4. Halas had eight receptions for a career-high 168 yards against the Lord Jeffs on Saturday...Wesleyan freshman Vince Miller (Pittsburgh, Pa.) became the first Cardinal running back to amass at least 100 rushing yards in a contest in six years (48 games), as he gained 109 yards on 21 carries against Bowdoin on Saturday. The last Wesleyan RB to gain 100 yards on the ground was Young Douglas against Bowdoin in 2002. Freshman LB Cyprian Oyomba (Norwalk, Conn.) led all tacklers with 18 (12 solo), one of the highest totals by a player since the mid-1970's. Three of his tackles were behind the line of scrimmage, including a sack.
