Offensive Player of the Week

Nick Kmetz, Colby

(Sophomore, QB - Laurel, Del.)

Kmetz tossed four second half touchdowns of 26 yards or more in leading the Mules to a come-from-behind 34-31 win over Tufts on Saturday. Kmetz finished the day 16-for-26 (.615) for 273 yards with a rating 192.82. He also rushed for 53 yards for 323 yards of total offense.

Defensive Player of the Week

Matt Zanedis, Williams

(Senior, CB - Upper Saddle River, N.J.)

Zanedis and the Ephs' defense held Wesleyan to only 259 yards of total offense in a 34-7 victory. Zanedis blocked a Wesleyan field goal attempt on the opening drive of the game, then put Williams on the scoreboard later in the first quarter when he intercepted a pass and returned it 40 yards for a touchdown. He also contributed three tackles (two solo).

Special Teams Player of the Week

Kyle McAllister, Bates

(Senior, S - Exeter, N.H.)

McAllister returned three kickoffs for 82 yards, including one in the fourth quarter for 45 yards that set up the Bobcats' third touchdown of the game in a 28-24 victory over Bowdoin. He also contributed three tackles during the contest at safety.

Notes: With a week remaining in the regular season, Amherst has captured a share of the **2009 NESCAC Football Championship** thanks to a 23-12 win over defending champ Trinity on Saturday. A win by the Lord Jeffs at rival Williams on Nov. 14 will guarantee Amherst the outright conference crown, while the Ephs can claim a share with a victory over the Jeffs...**Amherst** junior ILB Brandon Quinn (Atlanta, Ga.) led the Lord Jeffs defense during a 23-12 victory over Trinity with 15 tackles (six solo), including a sack for a loss of six yards. Quinn also broke up four passes, as Amherst limited Trinity to only 238 yards of offense, the Bantams' lowest total of the season. Amherst is 7-0 for the first time since 2001. Junior QB Alex Vetras (Clyde Hill, Wash.) helped the Lord Jeffs earn their first victory over Trinity since 2001 by tossing three touchdowns as he finished the day 21-for-38 for 252 yards and an efficiency rating of 126.49. It was Vetras' second 3-TD game of the season, giving him 12 on the year. Senior punter Matt Eberhart (Plano, Texas) punted the ball seven times during the Jeffs' win over Trinity (30.1 average), landing the ball inside the Bantams' 20-yard line three times with a long of 34 yards...**Bates** sophomore DE Tyler Kuehl (Plymouth, N.H.) tipped a pass and caught it himself, as he sprinted 25 yards for a touchdown during the fourth quarter in a 28-24 victory. The interception and return gave the Bobcats the lead for the first time in the contest. He batted down two other passes and recorded two tackles in the win. Freshman QB Trevor Smith (Malvern, Pa.) completed 21-of-31 passes for 269 yards and three touchdowns while also rushing for a team-high 29 yards in the Bobcats' first victory over Bowdoin since 2003. Over the past two weeks, in his first two career starts, Smith is 52-for-82 for 630 yards and six touchdowns with an efficiency rating of 142.34...**Bowdoin** senior Bobby Welch (Dover, Mass.) had a forced fumble, a fumble recovery, and an interception to go along with five solo stops against Bates. RB Nick Tom (Newton Square, Pa.) totaled 168 yards of total offense, including a game-high 73 yards rushing, to lead the Polar Bears' offense on Saturday...**Hamilton** senior LB Landrey Mack (Weedsport, N.Y.) recorded a team-high 11 tackles (nine solo), including one for a loss of 12 yards, in a 37-14 setback at Middlebury. Landrey also broke up a pass and blocked a 35-yard field goal attempt. Freshman WR McCullough Shriver (Marlborough, Conn.) ran for a team-high 35 yards on just four carries and caught four passes for 29 yards...**Middlebury** senior DL Taylor Robinson (Summit, N.J.) ended Saturday's victory over Hamilton with seven tackles (five solo), including 4.5 for a loss of 17 yards. He also had a sack for a loss of three yards. Senior QB Donald McKillop (Poway, Calif.) guided the Panthers to their third-straight win by throwing for 406 yards with four touchdowns, as he went 34-for-50. He also scored a touchdown on a one-yard rush in the third quarter. McKillop now has 19 touchdown passes on the year, tying the single-season program record...**Trinity** senior safety John Marinelli (New Canaan, Conn.) made three tackles and intercepted two passes during the Bantams' 23-12 loss at Amherst on Saturday. Senior RB Oliver Starnes (Ledgewood, N.J.) rushed 29 times for 117 yards and caught seven passes for 44 yards. Sophomore kicker Tim Costello (Solano Beach, Calif.) kicked field goals of 22 and 28 yards during Saturday's game...**Tufts** sophomore DE Donnie Simmons (Houston, Texas) had eight tackles, including two sacks for a combined loss of 17 yards, and forced a fumble in Saturday's setback at Colby. He also broke up a pass and had a QB hurry. Junior RB Pat Bailey (Beverly, Mass.) accumulated 293 all-purpose yards at Colby with 110 in returns, 109 rushing and 74 receiving. He also scored two touchdowns, including a 94-yard run that put the Jumbos up 21-7 with 9:01 remaining in the second quarter. His 48-yard kickoff return set up Tufts' first touchdown, which he ran in from four yards out...**Wesleyan** sophomore DB Jordan Greene (Titusville, Fla.) led all tacklers in Saturday's game with 11 (nine solo) and also forced a fumble in the contest...**Williams** junior RB Ryan Lupo (Princeton, N.J.) gained 114 yards on the ground during a 34-7 win at Wesleyan on Saturday, with 94 yards coming in the second half. Lupo also had three touchdowns and caught one pass for 14 yards.
