**Men's Basketball Player of the Week**

**Bryan Wholey, Bates**

(Senior, Guard - Marshfield, Mass.)

Wholey led the Bobcats to a 2-0 road week, averaging 22.5 points, 8.0 rebounds, 4.0 assists and 3.0 steals per game while averaging 39.0 minutes per game. Wholey tied his career-high in scoring which he set last year against Tufts by pouring in a game-high 28 points in a 72-68 overtime victory over the Jumbos on Saturday afternoon. For the week, Wholey went 16-for-33 from the floor (.485) and 12-for-15 from the foul line (.800). Wholey is third among all conference players in scoring at 16.3 points per game.

**Notes:** Amherst senior center Kevin Hopkins (Greenfield Center, N.Y.) helped his team to a 3-0 week by averaging 14.3 points, 3.7 blocks, 2.3 assists and 2.3 rebounds per game while shooting at a 62.1 percent clip from the floor and going 7-for-7 from the line. During Saturday's win at Williams, Hopkins scored a game-high 20 points, hitting nine of his 13 shots, while blocking six shots...Bowdoin senior forward Jordan Fliegel (Cambridge, Mass.) averaged 21.0 points and 6.5 rebounds per game as the Polar Bears went 2-0 last week to improve to a program-best 15-3 record. Fliegel connected on 13 of his 20 shots (.650) and came within one point of his season-high by scoring 25 during Saturday's win over Wesleyan...Colby senior guard Mark Gaudet (Bingham, Maine) averaged 18.5 points per game as he shot 68 percent from the field and 67 percent from three-point range in a 1-1 week for the Mules. Gaudet had a game-high 18 points during Friday's win over Wesleyan and a team-high 19 points in Saturday's loss to Connecticut College...Connecticut College senior forward Charles Stone (Hackensack, N.J.) averaged 14.7 points, 5.7 rebounds and 5.0 assists during a 2-1 week for the Camels, hitting 59 percent (16-for-27) of his shots. Stone scored a game-high 20 points along with grabbing six boards in a setback to Bowdoin on Friday. Teammate Christian Mosley netted 15 of his career-high 24 points in the second half of Saturday's victory over Colby. Mosley was a perfect 10-for-10 from the foul line and went 4-for-7 from three-point range...Middlebury junior forward Aaron Smith (West Hartford, Conn.) averaged 16.0 points and 11.5 rebounds per game over two games for the Panthers last week. Smith hit 43.2 percent of his shots from the floor, and also blocked two shots...Trinity senior guard Patrick Hasiuk (Enfield, Conn.) scored a team-high 20 points, going 4-for-6 from behind the arc and hitting 6-of-7 free throw attempts, during a win at Middlebury on Saturday afternoon. He averaged 14.0 points and 3.0 assists per game over two games last week...Wesleyan junior Kevin Scura (Concord, N.H.) led the Cardinals in scoring against Colby over the weekend, recording 17 points off the bench. Scura connected on three of his five three-point attempts...Williams sophomore guard Kevin Snyder (Littleton, Colo.) averaged 14.5 points per game during a split week for the Ephs. During Friday's win over Trinity, Snyder had 10 points, two rebounds, two assists and two steals. He closed the week on Saturday with a team-high 19 points and grabbed two boards.
