Player of the Week:

Chris Wilson Bates (Junior–Brewer, ME)

Bates Chris Wilson averaged 19.5 points, 4 rebounds, and 4 assists per game. He shot an impressive 52 percent (13-of-25) including 6-of-8 from behind the three point arc. He scored a career high 24 points on 8-of-12 (.666%) shooting from the floor, grabbed 4 rebounds and dished out 7 assists in a loss versus Amherst. He had 15 points and 4 rebounds as the Bobcats beat Trinity 54-53.

Brandon Fox UMFK (Freshman-Deptford, NJ)

Fox averaged 20.6 points per game in a 3-0 week for the Bengals. He was an impressive 26-of-44 from the floor. He also grabbed 9.3 rebounds per contest. Fox dropped 25 points and grabbed 9 rebounds in a victory over University of Maine at Presque Isle.
