## ~ All-State Awards ~



**Josh Jones, Husson University**  
*Player of the Year*

Jones was a force on both ends of the court for Husson this season, helping lead the Eagles to a 21-7 overall mark and a berth in the NCAA Division III National Championship. A senior forward from Jefferson, Maine, Jones ranked third in the state in points per game (19.2) and second in rebounding (11.4), and finished in the top 10 in four other statistical categories. The North Atlantic Conference (NAC) Player of the Year matched his season-high of 32 points and grabbed 14 boards as he concluded his career with an

NCAA Tournament game against last year's national runner-up, Williams. Husson put a real scare into the Ephs, before dropping an 89-86 overtime decision.



**Franklin Salvador, Thomas College**  
*Rookie of the Year*

Salvador makes it two consecutive years that the Association's top rookie award goes to a member of the Terriers. A native of Somerville, Mass., he averaged 12.3 points per contest for the nation's third-ranked scoring offense. As Thomas reached the North Atlantic Conference (NAC) semifinals, Salvador connected on 13 three-pointers and tallied 46 points in those two games. On the season, he shot just under 42 percent from long distance, and recorded 84 of his 106 made field goals from behind the three-point arc.



**Warren Caruso, Husson University**  
*Coach of the Year*

Caruso guided the Eagles to their second straight North Atlantic Conference (NAC) title and yet another NCAA Division III National Championship appearance. In his 16<sup>th</sup> season at the helm, Caruso passed the 300-win mark for his career at Husson with 21 in 2010-11, and now stands at 315. Named co-Coach of the Year by the NAC, Caruso and the Eagles went 12-2 through league play en route to capturing the seventh conference championship under his direction.
