#### Men's Basketball Player of the Week

##### Brian Ellis, Bates

(Senior, Forward - Braintree, Mass.)

Ellis scored the most points by a Bobcat in seven years with a career-high 33 during Tuesday's 76-72 setback to Southern Maine. He went 12-for-16 from the floor (.750), 2-for-3 from beyond the arc, and a perfect 7-for-7 from the free throw line. Ellis also grabbed four rebounds, dished out three assists, and had a steal. He moved to 27th on Bates' all-time scoring list, scoring 1,053 points over his career.

**Notes:** **Amherst** junior forward Jeff Holmes (Saunderstown, R.I.) posted game highs of 17 points and 10 rebounds in just 18 minutes of a 93-64 victory over Western New England last Tuesday. He shot 7-for-12 from the field (.583)...**Bowdoin** junior forward Will Hanley (New Canaan, Conn.) scored 21 points, grabbed eight boards, dished the ball three times, and also had two steals in the Polar Bears' 80-39 road victory over the University of New England on Tuesday...**Colby** senior guard Christian Van Loenen (Falmouth, Maine) recorded a team-high 14 points, three assists, and two steals in an 87-66 setback at Western Conn. St. on Tuesday...**Connecticut College** sophomore forward Boris Jeremic (Rijeka, Croatia) had 14 points and five rebounds in Tuesday's 65-57 loss to Roger Williams. Jeremic scored nine of his 14 points in the second half to ignite a 21-to-4 Camel run. Taylor Hanson netted 14 points and pulled down eight rebounds, going 6-for-9 from the field...**Middlebury's** front court duo of Ryan Sharry (Braintree, Mass.) and Andrew Locke (Seattle, Wash.) led the Panthers to a pair of victories last week. Sharry averaged 12.5 points, 6.0 rebounds, and 3.0 blocks per game while hitting 11-of-13 shots (.846). Locke averaged 12.0 points, 8.5 rebounds, and 3.5 blocks per outing, as he hit .643 percent of his shots...**Trinity** senior guard Brian Ford (Bronx, N.Y.) averaged 12.3 points per game, scoring in double figures in all three of the Bantams' outings during a 2-1 week. He had 13 points in a 58-53 setback to Eastern Conn. St., 14 points in a 63-47 win over Nichols, and 10 points in a 61-45 victory against Framingham St. in the championship game of the Harbor Invitational on Saturday...**Tufts** junior guard Amauris Quezada (New York, N.Y.) collected 13 points in the Jumbos' lone game last week, an 81-63 setback at Regis...**Wesleyan** sophomore guard Shasha Brown (Harlem, N.Y.) averaged 22.0 points last week for the Cardinals. Brown scored 25 against Williams on Tuesday, followed by a 19-point performance at Baruch on Saturday. Junior guard Jason Mendell (Bedford, N.Y.) posted a team-high 25 points in the 92-81, double-overtime loss at Baruch. Sophomore forward Mike Callaghan (Madison, Conn.) recorded his third career double-double in the setback, scoring 11 points and grabbing 10 rebounds...**Williams** senior guard James Wang (Sydney Australia) averaged 22.0 points and 4.5 rebounds per game in a 2-0 week for the Ephs. Wang hit 15-of-21 from the field (.714) and 3-of-7 (.429) from three-point range. In Sunday's 95-60 victory over MCLA, Wang scored a game-high 23 points on 10-of-14 shooting (.714). He also had six assists and five steals over the two games.
