#### Men's Soccer Player of the Week

##### **Greg Watts, Bates**

(Junior, Goalkeeper - West Chester, Pa.)

Watts made 16 saves and allowed only one goal (.941 save percentage) during a 1-0-1 week for Bates, which included a 12-save performance in a scoreless draw with Bowdoin on Saturday. In his seventh career shutout, Watts stopped six shots in the second half and made an additional three saves over two extra sessions. The tie snapped a seven-game winning streak the Polar Bears held over the Bobcats. On Tuesday, Watts had four saves, all in the second half, in a 2-1 win over Maine-Farmington.

**Notes:** **Amherst** senior forward Ian Rothkopf (Harvard, Mass.) had two game-winners during an unbeaten 2-0-1 week for the Lord Jeffs. Rothkopf recorded the decisive tallies in victories over Gordon (2-1) and St. Joseph's of Maine (7-0). He also assisted on Amherst's lone goal in a 1-1 draw with Tufts on Friday...**Bowdoin** senior goalkeeper Dan Hicks (New York, N.Y.) extended his personal shutout streak to 442:41 with a pair of clean sheets last week, earning the win in a 4-0 victory over Husson on Tuesday (one save) and playing to a tie in a scoreless draw with Bates on Saturday (three saves)...**Connecticut College** freshman netminder Casey Marini (Hampden, Mass.) registered a .929 save percentage over a 1-0-1 week for the Camels, making 13 saves and allowing one goal. During Saturday's scoreless draw with defending NESCAC champion Williams, Marini made three of his nine saves in the first overtime period. Earlier in the week, Marini stopped three shots in a 6-1 victory at Johnson & Wales...**Middlebury's** Harrison Watkins (San Francisco, Calif.) tallied twice in a 6-0 victory over Southern Vt. on Sunday...**Trinity** junior forward Daniel Mayernick (Gladwyne, Pa.) assisted on both Bantam goals in a 2-1 victory over Worcester St. on Tuesday...**Tufts** went unbeaten under first year head coach Josh Shapiro last week, as the Jumbos won at Endicott on Tuesday (4-1) and tied Amherst on Friday (1-1). Sophomore Franco Silva (Houston, Texas) and senior Ben Green (Burlington, Vt.) both had two goals at Endicott...**Wesleyan** sophomore Walter Rodriguez (North Plainfield, N.J.) pushed the Cardinals past Springfield on Sunday, scoring in the 84th minute to give his team a 2-1 victory. Senior Jacob Mergendoller (Mill Valley, Calif.) had the lone tally in a 1-0 win at Colby on Saturday...**Williams** senior forward Charles Romero (Mansfield, Mass.) had a hand in all three of the Ephs' goals in a 3-2 overtime win at New Paltz St. on Wednesday. Romero scored the first two goals for Williams and assisted on the third in the extra session.
