

2010 New England Division III Men's Indoor Track & Field Championships
Entry Procedures
General Entry Information

All Entry procedures will be handled by Direct Athletics. If not familiar with this service visit <http://www.directathletics.com/> now to set up your team's file.

The final date to qualify for this meet is Sunday February 14th. Performances generated after that date but before the start of the Championship cannot be used for qualifying or seeding purposes. Final Declarations for all events will be made by Midnight Tuesday February 16th.

Specific Entry Information

Step 1: Final declarations for all events must be made by Tuesday February 16th midnight. Declarations made after that point will be subject to late fees as defined in the Association's Constitution. Late declarations will only be accepted through Wednesday February 17th by 6:00pm. All submitted performances must be verified and listed on the Direct Athletics Performance List.

Step 2: Qualified and entered athletes will be posted on the meet web site at the "**Declared Entries**" link on Wednesday, February 17th at 8:00 PM. At that point a 24 hour protest period will begin. Anyone wishing to protest an entry must do so in writing to the Meet Director (<mailto:afereshe@bates.edu>). Protests of entries shall be acted upon by the Games Committee. All entries shall become final after the conclusion of the protest period and will be listed as final on the web site.

Step 3: The Games Committee will make all final determinations as to field composition and qualifying parameters. Seeding will take place and will be posted on the meet web site at the "**Heat Sheets**" link by Friday evening. All events will be seeded and run *as is* with the exception of the relay events which will be seeded 20 minutes prior to the event at the conclusion of the event check-in process.

Step 4: Scratches are requested and will be accepted up to 12:00 noon on Friday December 19th. E-mail any scratches directly to the Meet Director. After the final declarations are made, if an athlete is scratched out of any event he is out of the entire meet including relays.
