## Player of the Week: **Meg Coffin, Bates College (Senior – Westford, MA)**

Coffin averaged 13.7 points and 7.3 rebounds in the team's 3-0 week. The senior shot a blistering 18-27 (67%) from the floor including a 15-point and 11-rebound effort in Bates' victory over William Paterson. In the championship game of the tournament against Wesleyan, Coffin had 12 points (6-9 from the floor), 8 rebounds and 3 assists. She was named to the Holiday Inn/Naismith Classic all-tournament team hosted by Springfield College. In the William Paterson game, Coffin scored her 1000<sup>th</sup> career point.

Welch averaged 9.5 points, and 10 rebounds per game in a 1-1 week for the Lady Mariners. She followed that up with 7 points and 9 rebounds in only 20 against UMaine Presque Isle on Saturday. Welch was named to the all-tournament team for her efforts.
