Women's Basketball Player of the Week Lauren Yanofsky, Bates

(Junior, Forward - Belmont, Mass.)

Yanofsky averaged 17.3 points, 8.3 rebounds, 4.0 assists and 1.7 steals per game during a 2-1 week for the Bobcats. Yanofsky started the week with 17 points and 10 rebounds in an 83-61 win over the University of New England. She followed with her second double-double of the week, another 17-point, 10-rebound effort in a 64-59 decision over rival Bowdoin on Thursday. Yanofsky closed out the week with her best shooting performance, going 8-for-15 with 18 points, five rebounds and four steals in a 66-55 setback to Tufts. She shot .489 percent on the week (23-for-47).

Notes: Amherst sophomore forward Jaci Daigneault (Guilford, Conn.) led the Jeffs during a 2-0 week that included victories over Wesleyan and Williams. She registered 11.5 points and 7.5 rebounds per game as she shot .611 from the field...Bowdoin sophomore guard Katie Bergeron (Bradley, Maine) averaged 13.7 points for the Polar Bears during a 2-1 week. Bergeron had 17 points in a 75-50 win over Emmanuel on Saturday. On Thursday evening at Bates, Bergeron poured in a season-high 20 points...Colby sophomore forward Julianne Kowalski (Montville, N.J.) averaged 16.5 points in setbacks to Southern Maine and Husson last week. She leads the Mules in scoring, field goal percentage, and free throw percentage... Connecticut College first year guard Jennifer Shinall (Redding Ridge, Conn.) led the Camels to a 3-0 week, averaging 17.7 points, 6.3 assists, 6.0 steals and 4.3 rebounds over the three victories. Her best performance of the week came on Tuesday evening against Johnson & Wales, scoring 23 points along with nine assists and six rebounds in the 98-82 victory. Shinall leads the NESCAC in steals (4.09 per game) and assist-to-turnover ratio (2.25) while ranking sixth in scoring (13.6 points per game)... Middlebury's Kaitlin Fallon (Swathmore, Pa.) averaged 11.3 points and 5.7 rebounds per game in a 2-1 week... Trinity first year guard Michelle Royals (Torrington, Conn.) averaged 15.7 points, 4.0 rebounds and 2.0 steals per game in a 3-0 week. Royals had a team-high 19 points in a 74-46 win at St. Joseph (Conn.) on Thursday, followed by a game-high 17 points with four rebounds, three assists and three steals in a 52-28 win at Simmons. At 11-0, Trinity is off to its best start since the 1996-97 season... Tufts junior forward Julia Baily (Farmington, Conn.) averaged 16.8 points and 9.5 rebounds in a 2-0 week, Baily had a double-double with 14 points and 13 rebounds during a 65-55 win at Emmanuel on Wednesday, as the Jumbos regrouped for the win after trailing by 11 at halftime. In Saturday's 66-55 victory at Bates, Baily tied for the game-high with 18 points... Wesleyan senior forward Ali Fourney (East Northport, N.Y.) led the Cardinals in scoring for the fifth game in a row with 19 points in a last-minute setback at Amherst on Wednesday, 57-54. Fourney also had six rebounds, two assists and two steals in the contest.
