### Women's Basketball Player of the Week

#### Val Beckwith, Bates

(Senior, Forward - Woburn, Mass.)

Beckwith led the Bobcats to a 3-0 week and a 2-0 start to the NESCAC slate, averaging 21.0 points, 5.3 rebounds, 4.7 assists and 1.7 steals per game while shooting .512 from the floor (22-for-43) and .810 from the foul line (17-for-21). On Tuesday against Colby, Beckwith scored the game-winning layup as time expired in the Bobcats 73-71 win, as she finished the contest with 21 points. During Friday's 80-67 victory over Middlebury, Beckwith had a season-high 26 points along with nine rebounds and seven assists, going 10-for-16 from the field. She closed the week with 16 points, six rebounds and five assists in Saturday's 90-67 decision over Williams. Beckwith is second in the NESCAC in scoring, averaging 18.3 points per game.

**Notes:** **Amherst** first year point guard Shannon Finucane (Cortland, N.Y.) led the Jeffs to a 3-0 week as she averaged 14.0 points, 3.3 assists, 3.3 steals and 2.3 rebounds per game while only averaging 24.0 minutes. Finucane had 17 points against Springfield on Monday before pouring in a career-high 19 at Wesleyan on Friday. Amherst improved to 16-0 and is only one of four undefeated teams remaining in Division III...**Bowdoin** junior forward Caitlin Hynes (Owl's Head, Maine) scored a career-high 24 points, grabbed seven boards and collected four blocks in a 73-49 win at Colby on Saturday...**Colby** first year forward Rachael Mack (Augusta, Maine) averaged 14.3 points and 6.7 rebounds, hitting .607 percent of her shots (17-for-28) and .900 from the line (9-for-10) over three contests for the Mules. Mack posted a collegiate high 24 points on 9-of-14 shooting along with seven rebounds during Saturday's setback to Bowdoin. Earlier in the week at Bates, Mack earned a double-double with 10 points and 10 rebounds in a 73-71 loss...**Connecticut College** first year forward Kim Horne (West Lebanon, N.H.) averaged 12.0 points, 3.5 rebounds and 2.0 steals per game over two outings last week. Horne went 14-for-15 from the foul line for the week...**Middlebury** first year Brittany Perfetti (Clifton Heights, Pa.) averaged 10.5 points per game last week for the Panthers, shooting .462 from the floor...**Trinity** junior forward Christine Card (Waterbury, Conn.) averaged 9.0 points and 6.7 rebounds per game, going 13-for-25 from the floor (.520) in a 2-1 week for the Bantams. Card had 17 points, seven rebounds and a pair of blocks during Saturday's 55-54 win at Wesleyan, Trinity's first victory over the Cardinals in eight years. The Bantams are off to their first-ever 2-0 NESCAC start and the best start since 1994-95 overall (13-1)...**Tufts** junior Casey Sullivan (Berlin, Conn.) averaged 12.5 points in a 2-0 week for the Jumbos, shooting .526 from the field (10-for-19). Sullivan had a career-high 15 points in a 60-41 win over Middlebury on Saturday...**Wesleyan** senior forward Ali Fournay (East Northport, N.Y.), GS Lucy Sprung (Wilmington, Vt.) and senior Meredith Lowe (Philadelphia, Pa.) combined for 50 points as the Cardinals equaled the largest margin of victory in the 69-game series with Williams, 41 points in Tuesday's win...**Williams** sophomore F/C Jessica Harris (Cortlandt Manor, N.Y.) averaged 12.0 points and 9.7 rebounds per game over three games for the Ephs last week. Harris had 16 points and 15 boards in an 83-62 loss at Tufts on Friday, then scored 18 points in a 90-67 loss at Bates on Saturday.
