Women's Basketball Co-Players of the Week

Val Beckwith, Bates

(Senior, Forward - Woburn, Mass.)

Beckwith earned Tournament MVP honors at the Salem St. Tip-Off Classic as she led the Bobcats to a 2-0 weekend. Beckwith averaged 19.5 points, 9.5 rebounds, 3.0 assists and 2.5 steals during the tournament. She grabbed a career-high 14 rebounds in a 58-39 win over Rhode Island Col. on Friday, then poured in 23 points, including 16 in the second half, in a 65-60 win over Salem St. on Saturday.

Emily Johnson, Middlebury

(Senior, Guard - Lower Gwynedd, Pa.)

Johnson averaged 20.7 points, 3.3 rebounds and 3.7 assists per game while shooting at a .474 rate from the floor in a 3-0 week for the Panthers. Against Springfield on Sunday in the Williams Tip-Off Classic, Johnson had a game-high 19 points to lead Middlebury to a 61-58 come-from-behind victory. For the week, Johnson converted 19-of-24 free throws and shot 7-for-16 (.438) from behind the arc.

Notes: Amherst first year center Lem Atanga McCormick (Chicago, Ill.) garnered MVP honors at the second annual Amherst Invitational over the weekend. Atanga McCormick averaged 17.0 points and 10.0 rebounds per game while shooting .667 from the floor. She also added 2.5 assists and 1.5 blocks per game...**Bowdoin** senior Jill Anelauskas (Medfield, Mass.) became the 11th player in program history to reach 1,000 career points as she netted a game-high 18 to lead the Polar Bears over Western Conn. St. on Saturday...**Colby** sophomore forward Julianne Kowalski (Montville, N.J.) was named MVP at the Colby Invitational as she averaged 15.0 points and 9.0 rebounds per game while shooting 59-percent (13-for-22) from the floor. Kowalski had game-highs of 18 points and 12 rebounds in an 83-63 win over St. Joseph's (Me.)...**Connecticut College** junior guard Jacqueline DeFeo (Stratford, Conn.) was named to the All-Tournament Team at the Babson Invitational. DeFeo netted 12 points against Babson on Saturday afternoon, going 4-for-8 from the field...**Trinity** junior forward Christine Card (Waterbury, Conn.) was selected as the MVP of the Cardinal Classic at Plattsburgh St. over the weekend. Card averaged 16.5 points and 10.5 rebounds over the two games, contributing 23 points and 15 boards in a 64-47 win over the host Cardinals in the championship game. Trinity is off to a 4-0 start for the first time since the 1999-2000 season...**Tufts** sophomore guard Colleen Hart (Needham, Mass.) came away with Tournament MVP honors at the Eastern Conn. St. Tip-Off Tournament, averaging 14.5 points, 5.5 assists and 4.5 rebounds while shooting .556 (10-for-18). Hart had 13 points, six rebounds and four assists in the championship game against the host Warriors...**Wesleyan** senior Ali Fourney (East Northport, N.Y.) averaged 17 points and 5.3 rebounds per game while adding in seven assists, three blocks, and 11 steals. Fourney was named to the All-Tournament Team at the Swarthmore Tournament...**Williams** sophomore Chessie Jackson averaged 17.0 points and 8.5 rebounds during an 0-2 week for the Ephs. During a 91-83 setback to Fitchburg St., Jackson netted 18 points on 8-of-14 shooting while grabbing nine rebounds.
