Co-Players of the Week: Katie Bergeron, Bowdoin (Jr. – Bradley, ME) Lauren Yanofsky, Bates (Sr. – Belmont, MA)

Bergeron led the Polar Bears to a 2-1 week in which she averaged 17.3 points, 5.3 rebounds, 2.3 assists, and 2 steals per game. The junior guard shot 38% from the floor and 88% (22-for-25) from the free throw line. Bergeron ended her week with a game winning shot with 45 seconds left in a thrilling 53-52 win over Trinity.

Yanofsky helped the Bobcats to a 2-0 week in which she averaged 21 points, 7 rebounds, 3 assists, 1 block, and 2.5 steals. The senior shot 50% from the floor (17-for-34) and set a career high in points in her team's win over Conn College.
