## Co-Players of the Week: Leah Rubega, Bowdoin College (Sr. – Norwich, CT) Annie Burns, Bates College (So. – Topsfield, MA)

Rubega led the Polar Bears to a couple of road wins over instate rivals USM and Colby last week. The senior forward posted a pair of double-doubles and connected on 65% of her attempts from the field. Rubega averaged 16 points, 13 rebounds, 3 assists, and 2.5 steals on the week.

Annie Burns led the Bobcats to a 4-0 week and was named the Tournament MVP at the Ed Hockenbury Classic hosted by Norwich. Burns was the catalyst for a Bates team that averaged 76 points in the four games. She averaged 6.5 points, 4.25 steals, and an amazing 7.3 assists per game.
