Women's Basketball Player of the Week

Allie Beaulieu, Bates

(First Year, Guard/Forward - Swampscott, Mass.)

During a 2-2 week for the Bobcats, Beaulieu scored a team-high 17.0 points per game while shooting 27-of-48 from the floor (.563), including an impressive 9-for-17 (.529) from three-point range and a 5-for-5 showing at the foul line. She also added 5.0 rebounds, 2.5 assists, and 1.0 steals per game. Her most impressive performance came in a 78-52 loss at Tufts, as she was 9-for-11 (.818) overall, 4-for-4 from beyond the arc, and 1-for-1 at the line to finish with a career-best 23 points. Beaulieu leads all league rookies in scoring with 13.2 points per game this season.

Notes: Amherst junior forward Jaci Daigneault (Guilford, Conn.) averaged 15.5 points and 6.5 rebounds per game in a 2-0 week for the Jeffs. At Williams on Saturday, Daigneault poured in a season-high 23 points and pulled down nine boards in a 75-51 victory...Bowdoin senior forward Leah Rubega (Norwich, Conn.) posted a pair of double-doubles during a split week for the Polar Bears, averaging 13.5 points and 12.0 rebounds per game on .578 shooting. Rubega now has six double-doubles over 11 games this season...Colby senior forward Alison Cappelloni (Sudbury, Mass.) reached 1,000 career points last week after scoring a team-high 19 on 7-of-9 shooting during an 88-58 win over Husson on Saturday. Cappelloni became the 13th player in program history to reach 1,000 points and now has 1,008...Connecticut College first year guard Bradie Hutchinson (Groton, Mass.) averaged 10.0 points and 3.0 rebounds per game off the bench for the Camels during a 2-1 week. Hutchinson had a season-high 14 points during a 66-57 victory at Eastern Nazarene on Thursday, going 4-for-5 from the field, 2-for-2 from three-point range, and 4-for-4 at the foul line...Middlebury first year Leah Kepping (Northport, N.Y.) averaged 13.8 points, 3.0 rebounds, and 3.3 assists in a 3-1 week for the Panthers. Kepping shot .489 from the floor while also earning a pair of steals...Trinity first year guard Carly Napier (Pittsford, N.Y.) had a team-high 15 points, six rebounds, seven assists, and a block in an 86-16 victory against St. Joseph's (Conn.) on Wednesday...Tufts junior guard Vanessa Miller (Cincinnati, Ohio) had nine steals in the Jumbos' 78-52 win over Bates on Saturday, the most by a Tufts player since December of 2000. The win upped Tufts' winning streak to 12 games, which matches the longest in program history set by the 2007-08 squad...Wesleyan sophomore center Eileen Gaffney (Manhasset, N.Y.) posted a pair of double-doubles during the Cardinals' 1-1 week, as she averaged 16.0 points and 10.5 rebounds per game on 10-of-22 shooting (.455) overall. During an 80-53 setback to Amherst on Wednesday, Gaffney had a career-high 22 points along with 10 rebounds. She followed on Sunday with 10 points and 11 rebounds in a 62-61 victory against St. Joseph's (Maine), scoring the game-winning shot with 6.8 seconds remaining. Gaffney also had five blocks in both games and finished the week 12-for-15 from the foul line (.800). Sophomore Sam LaCroce (Prospect, Conn.) had the 11th block of Sunday's win over the Monks, coming at the buzzer to thwart a potential game-winning layup...Williams' Chessie Jackson was a perfect 7-for-7 from the floor, 4-for-4 from beyond the arc, and led the Ephs with 20 points en route to a 71-52 win over Skidmore last week.
