Women's Basketball Co-Players of the Week Lauren Yanofsky, Bates Colleen Hart, Tufts

(Senior, Forward - Belmont, Mass.)
In only 23 minutes of action, Yanofsky had 22 points, 13 rebounds, six blocks, four assists, and four steals during a 96-80 win over Thomas on Monday. Down three points at halftime, Yanofsky helped the Bobcats to victory with 14 points on 7-of-9 shooting and seven rebounds in the second half. She finished the game 11-for-16 from the floor (.688).

(Junior, Guard - Needham, Mass.)

Hart averaged 21.0 points, 4.3 rebounds, and 3.3 assists per game during a 3-0 week for the Jumbos. Hart started the week with 22 points and five rebounds in an 80-71 win at Wheaton on Monday. She broke Tufts' career three-pointer record against Maine Maritime on Saturday, finishing with 21 points in the 61-43 win. Hart closed the week by earning MVP honors at the Regis Tournament with 20 points in the 78-56 victory. For the week, Hart was 24-for-41 from the floor (.585) and 11-for-18 from beyond the arc (.611).

Notes: Amherst sophomore guard Kim Fiorentino (Holmdel, N.J.) averaged 11.0 points, 6.0 rebounds, 4.5 assists and 2.0 steals during a 2-0 week for the Jeffs. She hit 8-of-17 from the floor (.471) and went 6-for-11 from three-point range (.545)...Bowdoin senior forward Leah Rubega (Norwich, Conn.) posted 10.5 points and 15.5 rebounds per game over a pair of non-conference wins last week. Rubega had 16 points with 11 rebounds on 8-of-10 shooting in Tuesday's 79-58 win over Husson, followed by five points and a career-high 20 boards in Thursday's 60-40 victory against Colby-Sawyer... Colby sophomore forward Rachel Mack (Augusta, Maine) averaged 15.0 points and 8.0 rebounds per game as she was 13-for-19 (.684) from the floor in a 2-0 week. Mack poured in a season-high 22 points on 10-of-12 shooting along with eight rebounds in a 74-64 win at the Univ. of New England on Tuesday...Connecticut College sophomore quard Jenn Shinall (Redding, Conn.) had 15.5 points, 6.0 rebounds, 5.0 steals and 4.5 assists per game in two wins for the Camels last week. Tuesday night at Roger Williams, Shinall poured in eight of her team-high 20 points during a 16-2 run to start the second half in an eventual 75-53 win. She added 11 points, seven rebounds, four steals and two assists in Thursday's 62-39 win at Pine Manor...Trinity senior C/F Christine Card (Waterbury, Conn.) averaged 6.7 points and 9.0 rebounds during a 3-0 week for the Bantams. She posted 10 points, 17 rebounds and six assists in Saturday's 69-46 win over Smith... Wesleyan sophomore Eileen Gaffney (Manhasset, N.Y.) had a pair of double-doubles in the Cardinals 2-1 week, collecting 16 points and 11 rebounds in a 53-51 setback to Worcester St. and 15 points and 10 boards in a 57-47 win over Hunter... Williams first year guard Grace Rehnquist (Sharon, Mass.) averaged 16.3 points, 2.7 assists and 2.3 rebounds per game during a 2-1 week for the Ephs, as she shot 16-for-34 from the floor (.471), 10-for-19 from beyond the arc (.526), and went 7-for-8 from the foul line (.875). She had a game-high 21 points in Saturday's 64-45 win over Hamilton.
