Co-Players of the Week: Courtney Cochran, USM (Jr. – Waite, ME) Annie Burns, Bates (Jr. – Topsfield, MA)

Cochran averaged 14 points and 11.75 rebounds per game in four games this week for the Huskies. The 6' junior shot 40% from the floor and 80% (24-for-30) from the free throw line. She recorded three double-doubles as the Huskies went 2-2 and set a career high with seven blocks against Chapman University.

Burns led the Bobcats to a 3-0 week with wins over UNE, Colby and MMA. Burns scored only two points against UNE but they proved to be important. Burns hit two free throws with 2.8 seconds left to cap off a huge comeback and gave Bates a 1-point win. She recorded 25 assists in three games and 13 steals.
