Samantha Goda, Maine Maritime (Sr. – Eliot, ME) Haley Jordan, USM (Jr. - Falmouth, ME)

Goda averaged a double-double of 16.5 points and 10 rebounds per game in a 2-2 week. She scored a career-high 27 points in the Mariners win over Colby-Sawyer, the Chargers first setback in NAC play. She also grabbed nine rebounds and blocked a shot on the night she scored her 1,000th career point. Goda was named to the Mariner Classic All-Tournament Team after putting up 31 points and collecting 22 rebounds in games against Salve Regina and Tufts. Goda was 25-for-50 from the floor and 18-for-21 from the free throw line.

Jordan was named the MVP of the Southern Maine Holiday Invitational helping USM to a pair of win and the tournament championship. Jordan scored a career-high 27 points in the Huskies 78-75 win over MCLA. She was 11-16 from the field and 5-6 from the FT line. She added four rebounds, three steals, four assists and one blocked shot. In the championship game, Jordan helped USM to a 68-66 win over No. 16 Babson. She had 14 points, eight rebounds, three steals, one assist and one block. At Husson she scored 19 points on 7-for-9 shooting in just 18 minutes of action and had three steals. In an LEC win vs. Keene State, Jordan led all scorers with 21 points and added six rebounds. For the reporting period she averaged 20.3 points, 5.0 rebounds, 2.0 assists and 3.3 steals per game while shooting 52.8 percent (28-53) from the field.
