Player of the Week: Maggie Smith, Maine Maritime (Sr. – Bath, ME)

Smith averaged 22 points per game in a 2-0 week for the Mariners. Smith scored a career-high 29 points in the Mariners win at Johnson State including a career high six three point field goals. Smith was 9-for-18 from the floor, 6-for-9 from three point land and 5-for-5 from the free throw line. She also grabbed three rebounds, collected two assists. Smith followed that performance with 15 points, three rebounds and two assists in a win at Lyndon which included three more treys. The senior guard shot 44% from the field and 50% from beyond the arc for the week.
