Player of the Week: Allie Beaulieu, Bates (Sr. – Swampscott, Mass.)

Beaulieu averaged 16.3 points, 6.0 rebounds, 2.3 assists, 0.66 steals and 0.66 blocks per game in a 3-0 week for the Bobcats, which included wins over UNE, Bowdoin, and Colby. She shot an outstanding 16-for-31 (51.6%) from the floor, 10-for-11 (90.9%) from the free throw line and 7-for-16 (43.7%) from beyond the arc. Her 22 points and 10 rebounds helped propel Bates in a close win against Bowdoin. She also scored 20 points in a win over UNE.
