Brown averaged 17.0 points, 3.7 rebounds, and 1.6 assists in an impressive 3-0 week for the Bobcats. The 5-8 sophomore had 23 points in a win against Bowdoin and shot 19-for-37 from the floor (51%) in her three games. Brown also connected on seven threes for the week. The Bobcats also defeated in state rival Colby this week.

In key conference wins over Rhode Island College and UMass Dartmouth, Garland averaged 22.5 points, 2.0 rebounds, 3.5 assists and 1.5 steals per game while shooting 55.0 percent from the field and an outstanding 61.5 percent from three-point range. In a win over RIC, Garland led USM in scoring and helped the Huskies grab sole possession of first place in the LEC with 22 points on an outstanding 14-for-15 effort from the free throw line.

Norton averaged 20.5 points while shooting 44% from the floor in a 2-0 week for the Beavers. Norton was also 14-for-16 from the free throw line in the two games. Norton also collected six assists and six steals.

Badeen scored a career high 26 points and collected a career high five steals in a win over Johnson State. The first year guard also tied a school record with seven three's in the game. Badeen connected on 10 three's in three games and shot 43% from the field and 39% from beyond the arc. She averaged 4.5 rebounds and 3.8 steals in the 2-1 week for MMA. In her only contest last week, Cahill scored 22 points and grabbed six rebounds. Despite the loss, the freshman forward shot 66% from the floor and also contributed two blocks.
