##### **Rachel Greenwood, Bates**

(Soph., Midfielder - Williamstown, Mass.)  
 Greenwood scored a team-high four goals, including three in the final 10 minutes as the Bobcats came back from an 11-9 deficit to win at Union on Sunday, 15-12.

##### **Michelle Smith, Trinity**

(Junior, Goalkeeper - Wayland, Mass.)  
 Smith was a dominant force for the Bantam defense during its season-opening win at Colby, stopping 20 shots while allowing just seven goals in a 10-7 Trinity win.

**Notes:** **Amherst** senior attack Alyssa Briody (Hopewell, N.J.) had a hand in five of the Jeffs' 10 goals on Saturday, scoring one while assisting on four others during a 10-5 win over Wesleyan. Trailing the Cardinals by a 5-4 score, Briody assisted on the game-tying goal along with the go-ahead goal before netting her lone marker to give Amherst a 7-5 advantage...**Bowdoin's** Jill Steigerwald, Bobbi Dennison and Christine Denitzio all scored three goals to lead the Polar Bears past Connecticut College on Saturday, 18-8...**Connecticut College** junior midfielder Lindsey Coit (South Portland, Maine) tallied five goals on Saturday against Bowdoin, adding in three caused turnovers and two ground balls...**Wesleyan** sophomore Laurel Sticklor netted the first two goals of Saturday's outing against Amherst as the Cardinals built a 5-3 lead before falling to the Jeffs 10-5.
