Women's Soccer Co-Players of the Week

Alix Vandeventer, Bates

(Junior, Forward - North Attleboro, Mass.)

Vandeventer had both game-winners for the Bobcats in a 2-0-0 week. After scoring the first goal of Tuesday's game in an eventual 3-0 victory against Southern Maine, Vandeventer put home the decisive goal in the 83rd minute of Saturday's 2-1 decision over Williams, Bates' first win against the Ephs since 2006. All three of Vandeventer's team-high three goals have been game-winners this season.

Scarlett Kirk, Middlebury

(First Year, M/F - San Francisco, Calif.)

Kirk tallied the first three goals of her career to help the Panthers erase a 3-0 deficit with 10 minutes to play and earn a key 4-3 overtime victory against Amherst on Saturday. Kirk scored twice in regulation to bring Middlebury within one, then won the match for her team as she completed the hat trick in the 95th minute for her first career game-winner.

Notes: Amherst senior forward Jackie Hirsch (Wilmette, Ill.) had two goals in a 4-3, overtime setback at Middlebury on Saturday. Hirsch leads Amherst in goals (4) and points (8) this season...Bowdoin senior Christina Aceto (South Portland, Maine) tallied her first goal of the season in Saturday's 3-2 loss to Wesleyan. Ellery Gould (East Sandwich, Mass.) notched her eighth goal of the year for the Polar Bears. She has now scored in each of Bowdoin's last five games...Connecticut College sophomore goalkeeper Kirsten Manville (Fairfax, Va.) had a .900 save percentage during a 1-0-1 week for the Camels. In Wednesday's 3-1 win over Rhode Island College, Manville had six saves. She followed with three more stops in Saturday's scoreless draw with Trinity. It was her second shutout of the season...Trinity junior goalkeeper Lily Pepper (Princeton Junction, N.J.) made three saves and did not allow a goal in the first half of the Bantams' 1-1 tie at Westfield St. on Thursday. She made three more saves over the second half and two overtimes in Saturday's scoreless draw at Connecticut College. Over 310 minutes this season, Pepper has not allowed a goal...Tufts' match against Brandeis was postponed due to rain and will unlikely be rescheduled. Sarah Nolet (Los Altos, Calif.) scored on a penalty kick in the first half to get the Jumbos going in a 2-0 victory over Colby on Saturday...Wesleyan sophomore forward Laura Kurash (Voorhees, N.J.) had a hand in all three goals during the Cardinals' 3-2, come-from-behind victory at Bowdoin on Saturday. Kurash assisted on her team's opening goal, then scored the game-tying and game-winning goals in the 46th and 49th minutes, respectively, to help Wesleyan end a 15-game winless streak against the Polar Bears (1994). It was Kurash's second five-point contest this season...Williams junior forward Brett Eisenhart (Portland, Ore.) netted a goal in each outing during a 1-1-0 week for the Ephs. In Wednesday's 2-1 win over Keene St., Eisenhart broke a 1-1 tie in the 60th minute. She leads the Ephs with seven goals.
