SEASON RESULTS

Women's cross country sweeps class wave races at Colby

WATERVILLE, Maine — The Bates women's cross country team started the 2012 season by turning the tables on rival Colby in the annual Bates-Colby Class Wave Races, sweeping both the First-Year/Sophomore and Junior/Senior races from the Mules on their 3-mile home course.

With the higher score winning (in contrast to typical cross-country team scoring), Bates won the Juniors/Seniors race by a convincing 33-24 score, and also defeated the Mules 30-25 in the First-Years/Sophomores battle, for a 63-49 combined win.

Colby, rated ninth in New England in the USTFCCCA preseason rankings, edged Bates in both races a year ago at Pineland Farms.

"We ran really smart races," said head coach **Jay Hartshorn**. "Everybody got off to good paces and were able to maintain them."

First-year **Hannah Zeltner** (Bedford, N.H.) won the First-Year/Sophomore race with Bates' fastest time of the day, 18:39.18, over 21 seconds ahead of the runner-up from Colby. Sophomore **Elena Jay** (West Hartford, Conn.) finished third overall in 19:18.79, and Bates' scoring (top five) wrapped up with sophomore **Erica Gagnon** (Weymouth, Mass.) fourth in 19:35.00, first-year **Addie Cullenberg** (Farmington, Maine) seventh in 20:29.08 and first-year **Isabel Ferguson** (Bainbridge Island, Wash.) 10th in 20:42.03.

Bates junior **Gabby Naranja** (Fort Kent, Maine), who transferred to Bates this year from St. Michael's (Vt.) College, led the Bobcats with a second-place showing in the Junior/Senior race, trailing only Colby senior Berol Dewdney, 18:36.65 to 18:48.19. Naranja also was the winner of the women's Alumni Race a week ago. Senior captains **Alicia Fannon** (Haverhill, Mass.) and **Amanda Solch** (Mountain Lakes, N.J.) were a strong third and fourth, in 18:52.90 and 19:02.50. Junior **Mira Carey-Hatch** (Laconia, N.H.) and junior **Andrea Fischer** (Williamstown, Mass.) were sixth and ninth, respectively, in 19:23.72 and 19:46.47.

No. 14 Tufts edges women's cross country at Pineland Farm

NEW GLOUCESTER, Maine — The Bates women's cross country team ran well against visiting Tufts University in a dual race between the fifth- and eighth-ranked Division III teams in New England. But the No. 14 nationally ranked Jumbos displayed better depth, resulting in a 100-114 win over the host Bobcats Saturday at Pineland Farms.

The scoring format of the meet went 10 places deep, as opposed to the more conventional five places.

Rounding out Bates' top 10 were sophomore **Erica Gagnon** (Weymouth, Mass.) 15th overall in 19:49, first-year **Addie Cullenberg** (Farmington, Maine) in 26th (20:34) and junior **Merrill Brady** (Concord, Mass.) 31st in 21:03.

No. 32 women's cross country takes third at Gordon meet

WENHAM, Mass. — The No. 32 nationally ranked Bates women's cross country team rested top runners thus far this season, but still made an impressive showing at the Pop Crowell Invitational at Gordon College, earning third place among 27 teams.

Among 317 runners in the race, Bates junior **Andrea Fisher** (Williamstown, Mass.) led the Bobcats in 12th place overall, at 19:09.4. First-year **Addie Cullenberg** (Farmington, Maine) was 14th in 19:16.6, followed by senior **Merrill Brady** (Concord, Mass.) in 21st at 19:35.0, sophomore **Sarah Fusco** (Cheshire, Conn.) 22nd in 19:38.2 and first-year **Isabelle Unger** (Charlotte, Vt.) in 31st at 19:49.1. Bates' displacers were first-year **Isabel Ferguson** (Bainbridge Island, Wash.) in 35th at 19:55.5, and senior **Lisa Reedich** (Harvard, Mass.) in 59th at 20:26.5.

An even 100 points had Bates trailing second-place Westfield (98) by two points, while Wellesley took first place with 51 points.

The Bobcats moved into the USTFCCCA's Division III Top 35 national poll this week at No. 32, while also moving from sixth to fifth among New England teams.

A full complement of Bates runners will compete at the RPI Invitational next Saturday, Oct. 6 in Saratoga Springs, N.Y.

No. 32 women's XC wins RPI Invitational

SARATOGA SPRINGS, N.Y. — The No. 32 nationally ranked Bates women's cross country team took first place among 12 teams on Saturday at the RPI Invitational, placing six runners among the top 20.

The Bobcats scored a match-low 59 points to outpace runner-up Plattsburgh State (80). Division II Saint Rose finished third with 99, followed by Vassar (104), Oneonta (111), RPI (124), New Paltz State (141), Stevens Institute (251), Cobleskill (267), St. John Fisher (278), Mt. St. Mary (330) and Sarah Lawrence (374).

Among 172 runners overall, junior **Gabby Naranja** (Fort Kent, Maine) paced the Bobcats in third place overall, covering the 3.04-mile course in 17:59.21. First-year **Hannah Zeltner** (Bedford, N.H.) took ninth place in 18:11.03. Sophomore **Elena Jay** (West Hartford, Conn.) and senior **Lindsay Cullen** (Newburyport, Mass.) were 14th and 15th, respectively, in 18:17.38 and 18:17.60, and senior **Alicia Fannon** (Haverhill, Mass.) capped Bates' scoring in 18th place at 18:24.70. Junior **Amanda Solch** (Mountain Lakes, N.J.) finished 19th (18:25.71) and junior **Mira Carey-Hatch** (Laconia, N.H.) was the Bobcats' other displacer, finishing 23rd overall in 18:36.37.

Bates competes next Saturday, Oct. 13 in the Maine State Championships, hosted by the University of Southern Maine at the Narragansett School in Gorham. The race starts at 12pm.

No. 27 Bates wins first state title since 1990, convincingly

GORHAM, Maine – The No. 27 nationally ranked Bates women's cross country team won its first State of Maine Cross Country Championship meet since 1990, and did so in convincing fashion on Saturday, outpacing runner-up Bowdoin by a margin of 38 to 61.

Bates' top seven all finished among the top 15 runners out of 154 overall. Junior **Gabby Naranja** (Fort Kent, Maine) led the way with a blazing second-place performance, finishing the 5-kilometer course at Narragansett School in 18:19, just three seconds behind repeat winner Molly Carl of Southern Maine, and three seconds ahead of last year's runner-up, Colby senior Berol Dewdney.

First-year **Hannah Zeltner** (Bedford, N.H.) finished sixth in 18:27, joining Naranja as an All-State honoree, which goes to the top seven individuals. Senior captain **Alicia Fannon** (Haverhill, Mass.) finished ninth in 18:36, starting a run of four straight Bobcats, as junior **Mira Carey-Hatch** (Laconia, N.H.) was 10th (18:49), junior captain **Amanda Solch** (Mountain Lakes, N.J.) was 11th (18:49) and senior captain **Lindsay Cullen** (Newburyport, Mass.) was 12th (18:53). Sophomore **Elena Jay** (West Hartford, Conn.) placed 15th in 19:02.

The Bobcats are ranked sixth in New England this week, while Bowdoin is rated eighth and Colby 10th.

Women's XC ties for 4th at NESCACs; best since '95

BRUNSWICK, Maine — The No. 28 nationally ranked Bates women's cross country team recorded its highest finish since 1995 on Saturday at the NESCAC Championship, tying for fourth place among 11 teams with Tufts.

The Bobcats and Jumbos both scored 138 points, finishing behind only Williams (45), Middlebury (71) and Amherst (107) in what is by far the toughest conference in Division III women's cross country. Bates outpaced sixth-place Wesleyan (153) by 15 points, followed by Bowdoin (161), Colby (186), Hamilton, Connecticut College and Trinity. Bates last finished fourth at the meet in 1995.

Bates junior **Gabby Naranja** (Fort Kent, Maine) led the Bobcats by placing 12th overall among 125 runners with a time of 22:13.19 over the 6-kilometer course, to become the Bobcats' first All-NESCAC performer since **Adella Myrick** '99 in 1998. On Tuesday, **Naranja officially earned Second Team All-NESCAC laurels** for placing among the top 14 runners.

Senior captain **Alicia Fannon** (Haverhill, Mass.) placed 29th overall in 22:36.67, followed by first-year **Hannah Zeltner** (Bedford, N.H.) in 32nd (22:39.52), senior captain **Lindsay Cullen** (Newburyport, Mass.) in 34th (22:41.16), sophomore **Elena Jay** (West Hartford, Conn.) in 41st to finish Bates' scoring. Junior **Mira Carey-Hatch** (Laconia, N.H.) placed 58th (23:22.17) and sophomore **Erica Gagnon** (Weymouth, Mass.) placed 66th (23:34.27) to round out the Bobcats' top seven.

No. 24 women's cross country takes 8th at ECACs

WILLIAMSTOWN, Mass. — First-year **Isabelle Unger** led the way for the No. 24 nationally ranked Bates women's cross country team, as the team's second string earned eighth place among 41 teams at the ECAC Division III Championships on Saturday at Mt. Greylock High school.

Unger (Charlotte, Vt.) covered the 6-kilometer course in an even 24:00, good for 20th place among 284 runners in all. Sophomore **Erica Gagnon** (Weymouth, Mass.) finished 41st overall in 24:38, and was followed by first-year **Addie Cullenberg** (Farmington, Maine) in 73rd (25:14), first-year **Isabel Ferguson** (Bainbridge Island, Wash.) in 75th (25:15), junior **Merrill Brady** (Concord, Mass.) in 87th (25:24) to round out Bates' scoring. Sophomore **Sarah Fusco** (Cheshire, Conn.) came in 110th in 26:01 and senior **Lisa Reedich** (Harvard, Mass.) was 119th in 26:08 to comprise Bates' top seven.

With 281 points, Bates placed between seventh-place Colby (240) and ninth-place William Smith (333). Middlebury placed first.

Bound for NCAAs? Women's XC 4th at New Englands

WESTFIELD, Mass. — The No. 25 nationally ranked Bates women's cross country team may have punched its ticket for its first team appearance at the NCAA Division III Championships since 1997, thanks to the Bobcats' fourth-place finish out of 51 teams at Saturday's NCAA New England Regionals at Westfield State.

Bates scored 145 points, finishing behind only No. 1 MIT (58), No. 3 Williams (75) and No. 5 Middlebury (89), and surprisingly well ahead of fifth-place and 17th-ranked Amherst (190) and sixth-place and 20th-ranked Tufts (210).

Bates' second through sixth runners were all better than their counterparts on all but the top three teams, underscoring Bates' powerhouse performance.

Junior **Gabby Naranja** (Fort Kent, Maine) led the Bobcats, finishing in 14th place among 366 runners overall. Naranja covered the 6-kilometer course in 22:05.23, and was the first of four Bobcats who earned All-New England honors by placing among the top 35 individuals.

Sophomore **Elena Jay** (West Hartford, Conn.) was the breakthrough performer of the day, finishing 25th overall in 22:18.03. Senior captain **Alicia Fannon** (Haverhill, Mass.) claimed All-New England laurels for the second straight year, placing 32nd in 22:23.97, and first-year **Hannah Zeltner** (Bedford, N.H.) came in 35th in 22:29.23, the fifth-fastest rookie in the field.

Junior **Mira Carey-Hatch** (Laconia, N.H.) finished in 39th place with her time of 22:36.13, a remarkably high placement for Bates' fifth and final point-scorer. Junior captain **Amanda Solch** (Mountain Lakes, N.J.) was 54th in 22:51.50, and senior captain **Lindsay Cullen** (Newburyport, Mass.) was the team's second displacer, in 90th overall at 23:26.50.

The top two teams at the meet, MIT and Williams, are guaranteed berths in next Saturday's NCAA championship race, in Terre Haute, Indiana. Middlebury, Bates and possibly Amherst are more than likely to receive at-large bids.

Women's cross country finishes 19th at NAAs

TERRE HAUTE, Ind. – For a team making its first appearance in the NCAA Division III Cross Country Championship for the first time since 1997, 19th place in the nation sounds pretty sweet.

"It feels pretty amazing that we were 11th in our region [New England] last year, and 19th in the country this year," said eighth-year head coach **Jennifer "Jay" Hartshorn**. "All in all, I thought we did really, really well. Everyone kept fighting the whole way through."

Led by senior captain **Alicia Fannon** (Haverhill, Mass.), the 17th-ranked Bobcats, who just entered the top 20 in the national rankings two weeks ago, backed it up by finishing with 424 points, trailing 18th-place Calvin (413) by only 11 points and 29 points ahead of 20th-place Lewis & Clark (453). Bates had its fifth and final point-scoring runner, junior **Mira Carey-Hatch**, cross the finish line ahead of any other New England team's fifth runner. Even better, Bates' sixth runner, sophomore **Elena Jay**, ran faster than all but three teams' in the country.

Fannon came in an impressive 59th place among 277 runners, covering the 6-kilometer course in 22:26.6. After Fannon, there were no spectacular performances, just gritty ones. Bates saw its top five cross the finish line before any other New England team's top five, and its top seven were in before all but one New England rival's, Middlebury's.

Junior **Gabby Naranja** (Fort Kent, Maine) came in 129th overall, leading three Bates runners amid a very tight pack at 22:57.5, with senior captain **Lindsay Cullen** (Newburyport, Mass.) close behind in 134th overall among a tight pack at 22:58.3, followed right behind by first-year **Hannah Zeltner** (Bedford, N.H.) in 135th (22:58.8). Carey-Hatch (Laconia, N.H.) capped Bates' point-scoring in 157th, at 23:08.8.

Jay (West Hartford, Conn.) was close behind in 161st in 23:10.1, and junior captain **Amanda Solch** (Mountain Lakes, N.J.) was Bates' final displacer, in 207th (23:30.0).

The Bobcats ran just minutes after the **Bates men's team finished sixth overall**, tying for its best national finish ever. It is the first year that both Bates' men's and women's cross country teams have both competed as teams at NAAs.
